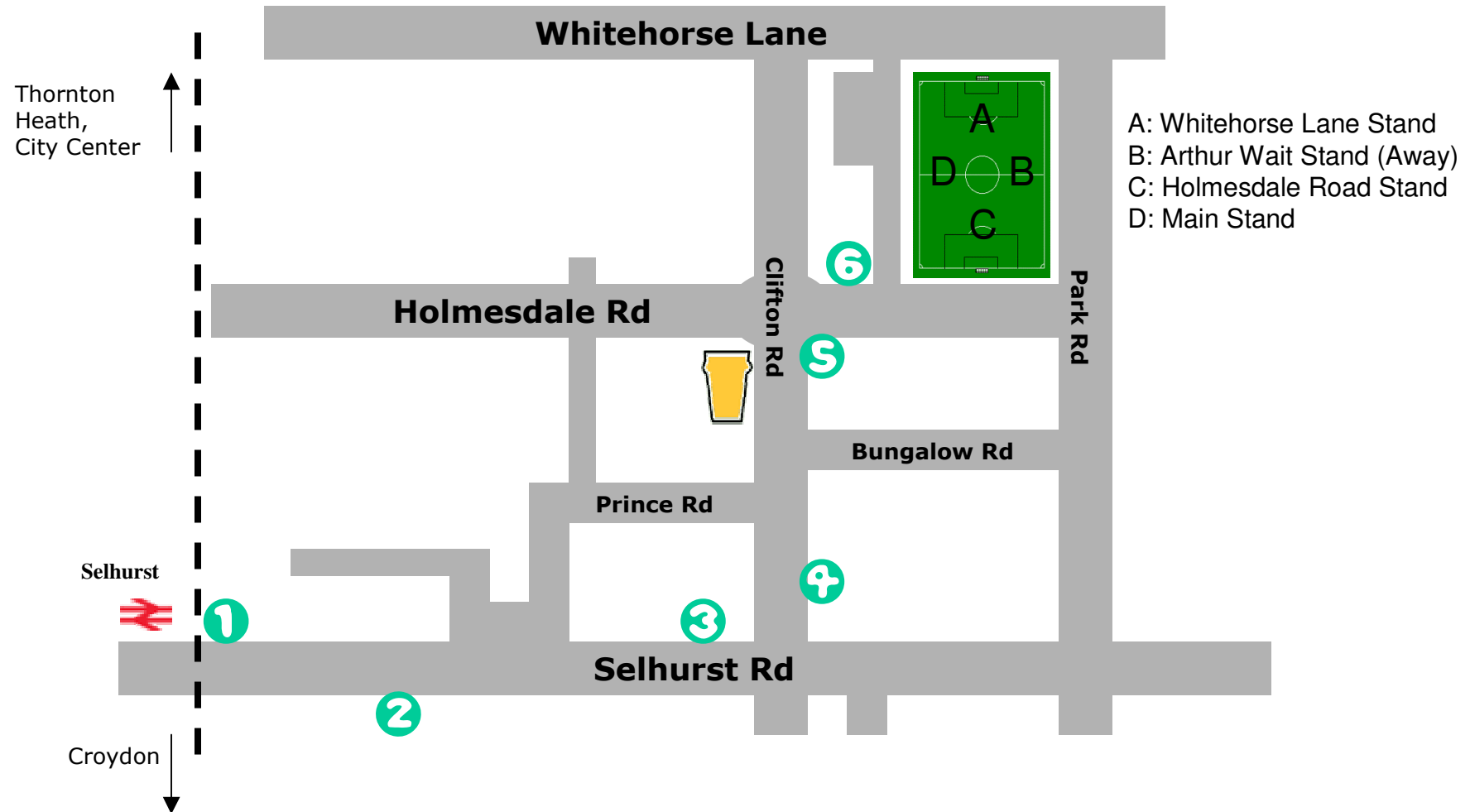

Crystal Palace (Selhurst Park)



1. National Rail to SELHURST

Selhurst is served with trains from Victoria, Clapham Jct or Balham. After leaving the station turn left into Selhurst Rd.

2. Follow Selhurst Road

Walk straight down Selhurst Road.

3. Turn left at the second junction

The second road on the left is Clifton Road. There's also a sign on the right side of the road which points into Clifton Road and leads the way to the ground.

4. Turn left into Clifton Road

..and walk down the road.



5. Follow Clifton Road to the roundabout

There's a pub right next to the roundabout (The Clifton Arms)-



6. Turn right into Holmesdale Road

After you turn right into Holmesdale Road, you can see the ground immediately. In order to get to the Ticket Office/Club Shop/Supermarket, turn left right in front of the Holmesdale Road Stand.

General Information

Line: National Rail to Selhurst (from Clapham Junction, Balham (Northern Line))

Travel time from Clapham Junction: 20 minutes

Walking time from station to the ground: 10 minutes

Alternatives: You can actually get to the ground by taking the DLR to Lewisham, and hopping on the bus. The bus ride however will take you about an hour...

After the final whistle: As visitors use Selhurst station as well as Thornton Heath station (which is also close to the ground), the stations normally aren't crowded. Additionally many Palace fans are from the area of South London and therefore don't have to travel back to the center by train.
