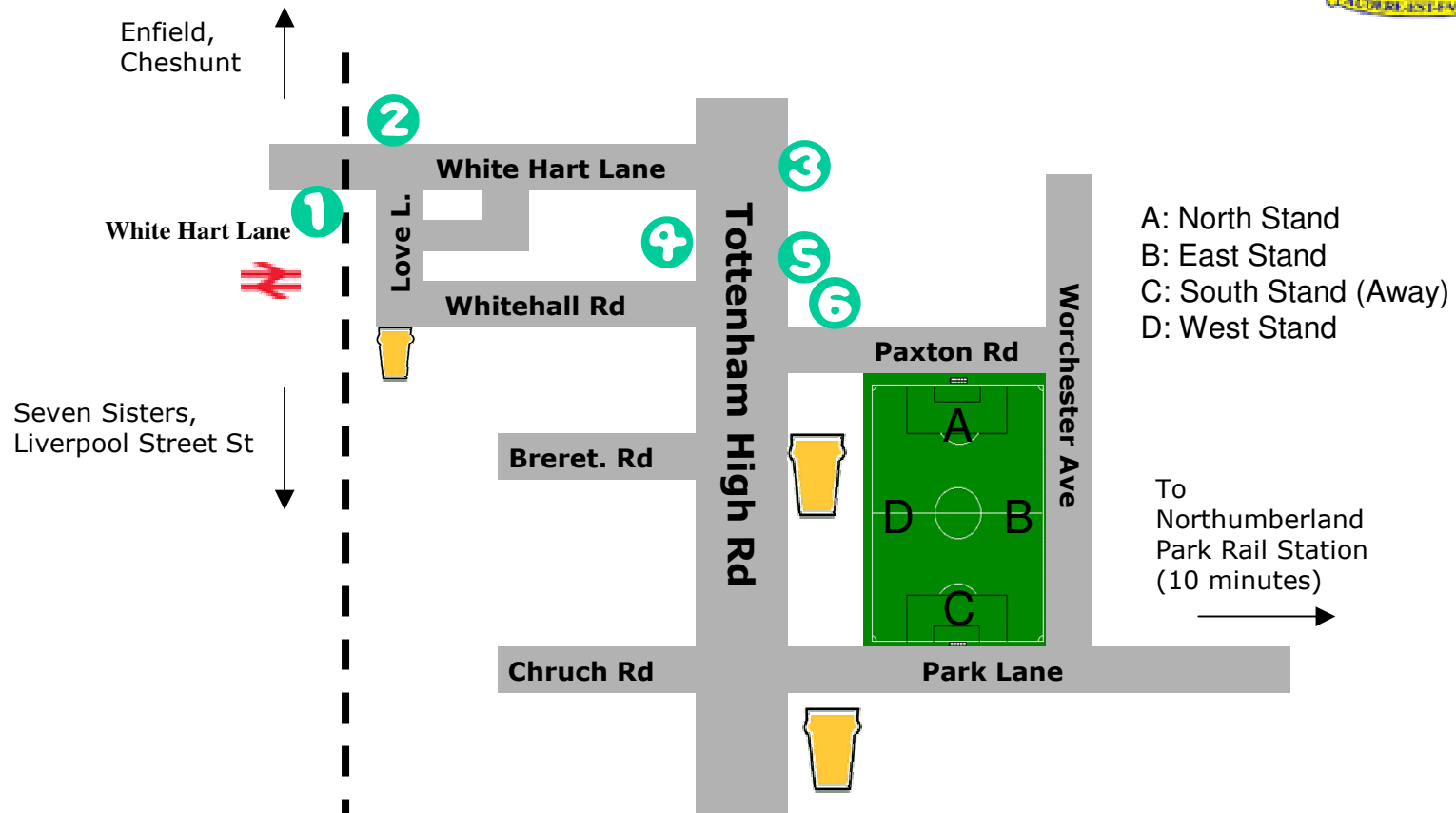


How to get to... Tottenham Hotspur (White Hart Lane)

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1. National Rail to WHITE HART LANE

White Hart Lane is served with trains from Liverpool Street Station. Leave the station and immediately turn right into White Hart Lane which goes underneath the railway bridge.

2. Follow White Hart Lane

Follow WHL which will take you to Tottenham High Road.

3. Turn right into Tottenham High Road

When you get to the corner of WHL and Tottenham High Road, turn right.

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4. Follow Tottenham High Road

The High Road will get you to the ground.



5. Pass the Gas Station Superstore

Pass the Spurs store, which has once been a gas station



6. Turn left into Paxton Road

Paxton Road is at your lefthand side. There you will find the Ticket Office. If you already have tickets or if your seats are not in the North Stand, you can also follow the High Street a bit further and turn left at Park Lane.

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General Information

Line: National Rail to White Hart Lane (from Liverpool Street, Destination Enfield or Cheshunt)

Travel time from Liverpool Street Station: 25 minutes

Walking time from station to the ground: about 5 minutes

Alternatives: You can also catch a train to Northumberland Park (from Liverpool Street or Stratford). This will also get you close to the ground, however trains don't run frequently. If you don't want to take the National Rail, you can go by bus or even walk from the tube station Tottenham Hale.

After the final whistle: The queue at White Hart Lane station is terrible and it will take some time to get into a train. So it's advisable to either walk down High Road to the Tottenham Hale tube station (busses are not running after the match!), or – and that's the best option – have a pint or two at a pub and wait till the queue has dissapeared.
